Our movement is founded upon this concept of eco-gastronomy — a recognition of the strong connections between the plate and the planet. Slow food is good food. We believe that the food we eat should taste good; that it should be produced in a clean way that does not harm the environment, animal welfare or our health and that food producers should receive fair compensation for their work." Sounds exactly what we need!!!

The Orange Region Farmer's Market is on the second Saturday of the month. It is an ideal time to meet the person who farms the product and discuss production methods. Unfortunately our AGM does not coincide with this week-end, but the FOOD week will make up for this.

It is possible to sign up for a cooking class with a focus on local, seasonal produce which may involve veggies, fruit and berries that you have picked yourself. What can be found locally? A veritable feast of seasonal food including vegetables, meats, jams, pickles, sauces, olive oils, wines, hazelnuts and apples of course. If that is now what you want you can try the local fine dining restaurants that are nationally celebrated, with several in receipt of Sydney Morning Herald Chef Hats.
